

## **MR. LOW NGAK TIOW Bursary-Terms and Conditions For Year 2021**

1. Name: This bursary is named "Mr. Low Ngak Tiow Bursary of New Era University College".
2. Description: This bursary is granted only to underprivileged students with verified financial difficulties.
3. Purpose: To encourage and provide opportunities for underprivileged students to complete their university education and to continue strive for the top in the academic field.
4. Quota: Limited to 10 underprivileged students.
5. Amount: RM 3000 per person.
6. Applicants shall be:
  - 6.1 New , current, or continuing students enrolled in New Era University College;
  - 6.2 Malaysian citizens or permanent residents only;
  - 6.3 Not concurrently receiving other scholarships and bursaries from New Era University College.

\* Note: This bursary will be deducted from the amount payable in the form of tuition reduction or exemption. Students shall be liable to repay the amount disbursed by New Era University College.
7. Qualifying criteria:
  - 7.1 Family currently facing financial difficulties;
  - 7.2 Excellent grades with active participation in school and department activities;
  - 7.3 Having good conduct.
8. Application procedures:
  - 8.1 Applicants may download the application form from the website of the Scholarship and Loan Committee of the Registrar's Office;
  - 8.2 Submit the application form and photocopies of the following documents:
    - i. Identity Card;
    - ii. Academic Transcripts/SPM/UEC/ etc. (Official Result only);

\* Note: New students enrolled in the May and July semesters of 2021 may apply using their UEC/SPM results. Current students may apply using their previous semester results as of the February 2021 semester (Please log in to the student portal and export the results as a pdf file).

    - iii. Student Organization Certificates / Awards;
    - iv. Personal Statement / Autobiography;
    - v. Recommendation Letter from middle school teacher / principal or enrolled department;
    - vi. Utilities Bills from the last 3 months.
9. Complete the application form and email it to the Scholarship and Loan Committee at [scholarship@newera.edu.my](mailto:scholarship@newera.edu.my) **before 5:00 pm on September 3, 2021.**
10. Announcement date of results: **20 September 2021**. Please refer to NEUC e-Notice for further information.
11. Incomplete application forms will not be accepted.
12. The Scholarship and Loan Committee will be responsible for reviewing the applications as well as arranging interviews via letter. Applicants will be notified of the application outcomes individually. The decisions made by New Era University College is final, and any inquiries will not be entertained.
13. The beneficiary students must write a thank you letter/card/or record a video to the sponsor to express their gratitude.
14. If any beneficiary student is found to have conducted themselves poorly, New Era University College reserves the right to cancel the bursary.
